

Collective Worship and Values Plan Autumn 1 2020

Intent

This half term we will focus on the School's promise to belong, believe, achieve. The world has looked very different for everyone this year and a reminder of how important everyone is, will help them reconnect with the school community and to think about what it means to belong to The Littletons School. We will look at love and how this connects us **John 15:12 This is my commandment that you love one another as I have loved you.**

Through worship children will learn about the Christian belief that Jesus brings hope, peace and joy and that he is the light of the world. The Christian values of wisdom and dignity are also explored.

This half term we will look at re-establishing routines for Collective Worship, in order that CW will continue to provide a calm and reflective experience where we all learn and develop our understanding of the moral choices we have and how our character is developed.

For children to develop a deeper understanding of the world in which they live, events and stories from all religions will be explored.

Implementation

Time will be set aside to deliver Collective Worship daily and the process of welcome, learning, reflecting and responding will be evident in each lesson through the use of windows, doors and mirrors. A trio of candles and worship resources to be used in classrooms or hall.

Due to restrictions of Covid 19 still in place, CW will take place in Key Stages. In Key stages, children will come together in worship through prayer, stories and songs. Last year we were unable to sing so time will be given to encourage and develop this as the children will be reminded of the joy and delight in singing together.

A new Liturgy and school prayer have been created by the children and this will be introduced through CW.

Weekly Pat on the Backs provides a chance to acknowledge and recognise achievements of individual and as these are carried out outside we are able to come together as a school community. These are communicated on the weekly newsletter in order to share with the whole school community.

We aim to re-introduce children to delivering worship through CREW invitations from Autumn 2.
